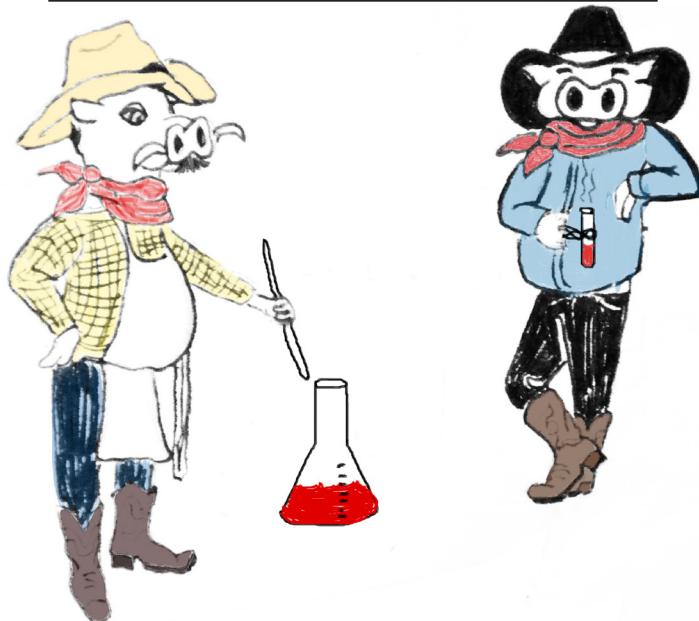


LaSalle County Fair & Wild Hog Cook-Off Science Fair 2017

2. ELIGIBILITY

Must be resident of LaSalle County or a student of Cotulla ISD, and must show proof of eligibility.
 Must be passing in grading period prior to fair week.
 No sexual or inappropriate subject materials will be allowed to enter!

3. JUDGING

Projects will be judged on a visual report, oral presentation, and a written report.

Oral Presentation will be judged on:

- Explanation of presentation
- Knowledge shown and how easily they answer questions
- Enthusiasm for project

Visual Presentation will be judged on:

- Appearance: eye catching, colorful, visually appealing
- Scientific Method: steps clearly shown with headings.
- Evidence of experimentation: data is shown clearly in tables, charts or pictures.

Written Presentation (booklet) will be judged on:

- Visual Appearance-neat-can be typed or handwritten
- Organization-cover, table of contents, research, interviews, reference page and experimentation notes
- Evidence of experiment: Explanation of scientific method in experiment.
- Evidence of analysis: Conclusion is clearly defined.

4. INDIVIDUAL OR GROUP ENTRIES -

Students may only enter one project.

No more than three individuals can be involved in a group entry.

All students entering their completed project must be present during the judging.

5. WINNERS

Each entry will be judged on its own merit and be awarded a First (Blue), Second (Red), or Third (White)

 Reserve Champion \$100.00 & Rosette
 Top 4 Blue Ribbon scores \$50.00 each
 (Honorable Mention)

PREMIUMS for Grades 9-12:

Grand Champion \$300.00 & Rosette
 Reserve Champion \$150.00 & Rosette
 Top 4 Blue Ribbon scores \$75.00 each
